#### Building an inclusive, diverse and active humanitarian movement based on voluntary service

#### Role purpose

Red Cross provides a door to door transport service for people who are elderly or have a disability and have no means of transport to urgent medical appointments. The Transport Driver will drive the participants according to the service schedule.

#### **Role responsibilities**

- Drive vehicle consistent with the SA Road Traffic Code. A probationary period of 4 weeks is required.
- Pick up and transport participants to their appointments in accordance with the daily schedule
- Ensure a safe, courteous and respectful vehicle transportation
- Assist participants with lightweight mobility aides such as walking sticks, frames, crutches etc
- Collect trip fees or donations from participants and issue receipts
- Maintain participant confidentiality, dignity and privacy at all times
- Report any concerns or issues, at the same time, protecting the clients privacy
- Use transport communication systems including an office or your own mobile phone and blue tooth Adhere at all times to the trip schedule provided
- Record and maintain a log book
- Inspect vehicle prior to commencing each trip
- Maintain the presentation and cleanliness of the vehicle

## Knowledge, skills and experience

- Excellent driving record and understanding of Road Traffic Regulations
- Show empathy for the mature aged, disadvantaged and socially isolated clients
- At ease working independently or as part of a team to share the workload
- Basic admin skills and knowledge of Microsoft Office including email
- Ability to read and use maps, street directory's or GPS navigation equipment

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- Ability to understand schedules and coordinate appointment

#### **Check requirements**

- You are between the ages of 25 to 60 years to comply with current Australian Government's advice to ensure the health and safety of our elderly community members.
- Current SA driver's license or equivalent
- A National Criminal History Check prior to commencement and renewed every three years (Red Cross will arrange this)
- Working with Children DCSI Child Related Employment (Red Cross will arrange this) \
- Volunteer Driver Accreditation Program (VDAP) It includes, Medical assessment, Driving Assessment and First Aid training (Red Cross will arrange this).

### **Learning and development**

- Complete Red Cross online learning modules as required
- Attend Red Cross Volunteer Induction, Program Training and ongoing training as required
- Attend scheduled volunteer meetings, a minimum of two per year
- Participate in Indigenous Cultural Competency Training

### **General conditions**

We are a Child Safe organisation and all volunteers are required to comply with relevant State and Territory legislation requirements

We comply with the Red Cross Workplace Health and Safety management system
