Role purpose

Assisting with collecting and delivering donations efficiently from various donation bins and stores around the metropolitan area of Adelaide. Contribute your skills to help us raise funds to support the everyday work of Red Cross

Role responsibilities

- Loading and unloading of stock at our warehouse, retail stores and other businesses, whilst ensuring lifting within the WH&S guidelines and driving in line with the Motor Vehicle policy
- Assist with picking, packing, receiving and dispatching accurately and efficiently
- Assist with occasional general storeroom duties, including grading of stock and stock take
- Conducting all deliveries and collections in a professional manner at all times
- Help record and maintain required statistics (e.g. Motor Vehicle Log Book)
- Identify hazards, assess risks and report incidents as required in line with the WHS policy
- Help to identify hazards, assess risks and report incidents in line with the WHS policy
- Maintain confidentiality relating to stores, warehouse, stock, customers, procedures and security

- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills with a positive and can do attitude
- Ability to work effectively as part of a team
- Being reliable and punctual
- Ability to drive a manual 1.5 tonne van
- Ability to comprehend and follow a Driver's Runsheets
