Position Purpose

This position will provide technical advice and project support into the planning and design of complete streets and transport network management to achieve best practice integrated transport and place making outcomes.

As a member of Transport Network Management team you will:

- Undertake site investigations, develop and prepare concept plans for capital works projects and assist with the implementation of integrated transport initiatives consistent with Council's strategic transport policies.
- Provide technical support to the team and deliver innovative and quality solutions that integrate community needs including road safety, transport efficiency, water sensitive design, streetscaping, urban design and green infrastructure outcomes.
- Develop and maintain external stakeholder relationships particularly with the Queensland State Government to achieve integrated transport outcomes.
- Provide input into the preparation of the annual capital works program to seek prompt delivery of integrated transport projects.
- Identify projects for continual improvement within budgetary constraints and maintain program and project schedules.
- Respond to allocated customer service requests in a timely manner ensuring that customer responses are well drafted and consistent with good community outcomes.
- Prepare and present complex strategic and technical reports on road safety and transport issues.
- Contribute to a positive team environment in order to achieve a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focused culture.
- Building strong relationships with key stakeholders including Council's elected members to ensure a service deliverables and best value integrated transport outcomes are achieved in line with Council's long term strategic vision.
