The Rural Clinical School of Western Australia (RCSWA) is a network of 15 rural and remote sites across the Kimberley, Pilbara, Mid-West, Goldfields, Great Southern and South West regions of Western Australia. It is a collaboration between UWA, The University of Notre Dame Australia, Fremantle and Curtin Medical School, operating as a unit within the UWA School of Medicine. Your role

The Medical Coordinator's (MCs) main responsibility is to assist with organising and teaching of RCSWA students or developing and coordinating rural training pathways for junior doctors. You will also be supported to develop in other academic areas (research, service, further clinical skills) depending on their interests.

Your key responsibilities

In consultation with local medical practitioners and agencies maintain and further develop local educational programs that meet the requirements of the RCSWA and take advantage of local opportunities and strengths

Deliver medical education and training to medical students and assist in the support of preceptors and host practitioners

Arrange learning opportunities for medical students by liaising with local agencies

Where possible, be involved in research and/or evaluation relevant to improving rural health

Develop and coordinate the development of rural training pathways in local area of appointment and contribute to a statewide RCSWA approach
