PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure the quality of installation, configuration and maintenance of hardware, operating systems and software including updates, patches and security patches to operating systems, software and firmware.
- Ensure network software and hardware facilities are operating at optimum levels and any failures are corrected, including troubleshooting, diagnosis and remedy of faults.
- Provide high quality support to AVN customers in fault resolution and service request provisioning.
- Ownership and improvement of network service quality and operational processes.

KEY DUTIES

- Maximize network performance by monitoring performance; troubleshooting network problems and outages;
 scheduling upgrades; collaborating with senior network engineers on network optimisation.
- Work within established configuration and change management policies to ensure awareness, approval and success of changes made to the network infrastructure.
- Secure the network by enforcing policies and defining and monitoring access.
- Liaise with vendors and other eSolutions staff for problem resolution
- Develop and maintain the network environment by designing system configuration; directing system installation; defining, documenting, and enforcing system standards and assisting with the development of network procedures/work instructions.
- Respond to service request and fault calls resolving the call within agreed service levels.
- Configure and install various network devices and services (e.g., routers, switches, firewalls, VPN, QoS).
