## **Key Accountabilities**

- Generate stories that are relevant to a broad section of Australians and reflect the cultural, geographic and socio-economic diversity of the country.
- Actively engage with communities to find and tell stories that are relevant for them and in line with the News strategy.
- Under general direction, build and output news bulletins to ensure the highest editorial and journalistic standards, and audience engagement.
- Check stories and content for factual and style errors/inconsistencies and ensure content is accurate, timely and innovative.
- Undertake a range of production tasks as directed by Supervising and Senior Producers across a 24 hour /seven-day roster.
- Contribute to the editorial discussion by suggesting and developing story and guest ideas to improve the quality, variety and diversity of News Channel content for all platforms.
- Assist with training of less experienced News Channel staff.

- Maintain a high-level understanding of all breaking and major developing stories, monitoring a wide range of media outlets/sources; develop and foster a wide network of contacts and sources.
- Actively promote the ABC values and apply all relevant workplace policies and guidelines.
- Cooperate with any reasonable instruction, procedure or policy relating to safety and take reasonable care for your own safety and that of other people who may be affected by your conduct while at work. Additional WHS responsibilities apply to Managers and Supervisors, Team Directors, and other Officers.

- 6. Proven ability to work accurately and to deadlines in a pressured environment.
- 7. Demonstrated understanding of programming priorities and objectives of ABC News Division.
- 8. An understanding of new media and how to best utilise it to generate audience program material.
- 9. A demonstrated and ongoing interest and passion in finding and telling stories that reflect Australia's diversity.
- 10. A proven ability to source and maintain contacts across the broader Australian community.
- 11. Demonstrated understanding and passion to source and create authentic content which represents the broad diversity of the Australian community, including stories that reflect a range of cultural and linguistic backgrounds and Indigenous communities where editorially relevant.
