To provide specialist planning expertise and undertake moderate to complex planning investigations for a range of stormwater and/or coastal projects to meet the needs of the community within the City of Moreton Bay area.

Responsibilities & Outcomes

As an Environmental Planner - Stormwater and member of the Drainage, Waterways and Coastal Planning department you will:

- Act as a technical planning advisor and provide guidance to team members in the delivery of stormwater infrastructure planning and policy matters to drive integrated and sustainable planning outcomes.
- Provide advice in infrastructure planning and policy matters in accordance with legislative, policy and business requirements.
- Investigate stormwater planning problems and prepare and present technical solutions and recommendations to ensure project outcomes are met.
- Coordinate, undertake and assist in the preparation of planning studies/assessments to support infrastructure projects delivered and grant applications by Council (including management of specialist consultants).
- Support project-based community consultation including representing Council as part of a team at a range of customer meetings and community forums.
- Support the development of team capability to drive a high performance, continuous improvement and a customer focussed culture.
- Build strong relationships and engage with internal and external stakeholders to ensure stormwater and waterway infrastructure and service delivery outcomes are achieved.
