### PURPOSE STATEMENT:

#### Position Dimension & Relationships:

The position is located within the Research School of Economics. The postdoctoral Fellow will work under the supervision of, and in collaboration with, Professor Markus Brueckner. As an academic member of the Research School of Economics, the appointee will be required to contribute to the overall intellectual life of the School, College and University. This includes contribution to research, education and outreach agendas of the School both nationally and internationally. The post-doctoral fellow will conduct high-quality research in the areas of development economics, international economics, and political economy.

### Role Statement:

- the conduct of research under limited supervision and the productions or contribution to the production of conference and seminar papers and publications from that research;
- involvement in professional activities including, subject to availability of funds, attendance at conferences and seminars;
- the presentation of research papers at leading international conferences such as the AEA annual meeting
- development of research-related material for teaching or other purposes with appropriate guidance from other staff;
- teaching – limited to one course per year. This includes, but is not limited to, the preparation and delivery of lectures and tutorials, the preparation of online material, marking and assessment, consultations with students;
- some administrative functions primarily connected with the area of research of the academic;
- attendance at meetings, school meetings and/or membership of a limited number of committees;
- advice within the field of the staff member's research to postgraduate students; and
- other duties as allocated by the supervisor or the Research School Director, consistent with the classification of the position.

**SELECTION CRITERIA:**

1. Completion, or near completion, of a PhD in economics is essential, with demonstrated expertise in development economics, international economics, or political economy.
2. Ability to conduct research, with the potential to publish in leading journals in economics.
3. An ability to teach in development economics or international economics. This may be evidenced by teaching experience and/or completion of graduate coursework.
4. A demonstrated understanding of equal opportunity principles and policies and a commitment to their application in a university context
