Position Purpose

Provide leadership in the delivery of Council's economic development agenda through evidence-based data. Achieve plans, goals and projects with an emphasis on identifying industry issues, trends and opportunities. Manage Council service level agreements and their performance/review in line with the Regional Economic Development Strategy (REDS) and oversight sponsorship contracts and commitments, ensuring appropriate return on investment (ROI). Be an internal resource across Council in the provision of economic development programming, advice and support and monitor, report, and review human, physical and financial resources.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

Operational

As a Manager of Business Intelligence and member of the Economic Development leadership team you will:

- Lead the development and implementation of local government systems and practices that support data led evidenced based economic development strategies, policies and practices.
- Maintain strong, professional partnerships with key representatives inside and outside of the region.
- Lead collaborative partnerships with industry to maximise access to and support the utilisation of relevant data sources that enhance business decision making, industry advancement and investment attraction.
- Provide internal support across Council on economic development policies, practices and methodology to assist in embedding economic development thinking, data and business intelligence in Council strategies, plans and policies.
- Maintain a deep understanding of the local business environment and impacts of global, national and local trends and conditions and applies relevant tactics to assist industry and support the REDS actions.
- Leads the novel integration of disparate data sources to generate unique insights to support local government funding advocacy and submissions and develop actionable insights, reports and proposals to communicate to stakeholders in a precise and compelling manner.
- Establishes reporting mechanisms that support the reduction of program waste and maximises the potency of local government economic development interventions.
- Provide strategic advice on the formation and formulation of key performance indicators and metrics for the Department and external contracts/service level agreements, to manage internal performance and external reporting including Council economic development grant and sponsorship programs (including their efficacy and governance framework).
