Purpose

Drive the daily development of coverage of international news from the ABC's foreign correspondents, to deliver original, timely and high impact storytelling, in line with ABC News strategy.

Key Accountabilities

- Drive the daily international newsgathering agenda, with a focus on commissioning stories for impact, with agreed priority platforms as a focus.
- Provide editorial oversight and leadership to the ABC's proposed three international news hubs, including the day-to-day management of Editors in Asia, Europe and the Americas and the associated bureaux.
- Ensure the highest standards of journalism, with coverage which reflects the principles of independence, integrity, responsibility and accuracy.
- Work closely with State Editors, Managing Editors and key program teams to ensure international news coverage is aligned with output needs and priorities in line with the News Strategy.
- Support Editors to make sound editorial decisions around the delivery on content; with audiences at the centre of commissioning discussions.
- Allocate production resources to support bureaux in the delivery of multi-platform content with a digital first approach.

- Originate and refine story and coverage ideas to drive distinctive and high impact international news content on a daily basis.
- Provide editorial leadership to the proposed multiplatform production desk to plan and produce cross-platform content.
- As required, report and analyse news, events, issues, trends and developments for all platforms with depth, immediacy and accuracy.
- Contribute significantly to the management and development of all international staff through regular feedback and effective performance management.
- Collaborate with the Managing Editor International, Newsgathering Editor, Planning Editor and other relevant teams to drive coverage on planned and breaking stories.
- Ensure daily editorial output is consistent with the ABC News Strategy.
- Generate stories that are relevant to a broad section of Australians and reflect the cultural, geographic and socio-economic diversity of the country.
- Actively engage with communities to find and tell stories that are relevant for them and in line with the News strategy.
- Actively promote the ABC values and apply all relevant workplace policies and guidelines.
- Cooperate with any reasonable instruction, procedure or policy relating to safety and take reasonable care for your own safety and that of other people who may be affected by your conduct while at work. Additional WHS responsibilities apply to Managers and Supervisors, Team Directors, and other Officers.
