1. Position purpose

The Clinical Psychologist – Suicide Prevention and clinical oversight will identify and address gaps in local suicide prevention systems and supports across the Wimmera region. A key focus will be to improve care coordination and service pathways for people at risk of suicidal ideation, attempted suicide or are bereaved by suicide.

The Clinical Psychologist will provide clinical oversight, senior clinical leadership and supervision for Step Thru Care clinicians, particularly where clinicians are supporting consumers who are at risk or have attempted suicide. The position will also take an active role in developing and implementing community-based suicide prevention activities.

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4. Key responsibility areas

Service delivery

- Provide clinical leadership and supervision for Step Thru Care clinicians
- Membership of the Step Thru Care Committee and Step Thru Care Clinical Governance and Supervision Committee
- Provide clinical oversight of the Clinical Governance of the Step Thru Care Program
- Facilitate regular peer supervision sessions with Step Thru Care clinicians weekly/fortnightly
- Identify gaps in suicide prevention systems and services across the Wimmera region and develop a plan to address the gaps, working closely with Step Thru Care committee, management, and clinicians
- Develop and implement community-based suicide prevention activities across the Wimmera region
- Develop a plan to improve care coordination and service pathways for people at risk of suicidal ideation, attempted suicide or are bereaved by suicide, and work closely with Step Thru Care management for implementation of the plan
- Advise the Step Thru Care committee and Clinical Governance Committee on gaps identified
- Review access and pathways to postvention services for those affected by suicide and suicide attempts and provide advice on areas where improvements can be made
- Review suicide prevention services to ensure that post intervention and aftercare support is provided, and if gaps are identified, develop a plan to ensure clear referral pathways which includes a range of services that offer support for individuals at risk or the community
- Embedding Lived Experience into Suicide Prevention
- Engage and/or partner with Lived Experience Peer Supports (consumer or carer groups, specifically those who have a Lived Experience of Suicide Prevention) and mentorship

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programs for people at risk or impacted by suicide to inform initiatives and monitor progress towards objectives

- Identify where improvements can be made to postvention services to better support those affected by suicide and suicide attempts
- Membership and participation on a Regional Community of Practice established by WVPHN

People and teams

- Undertake regular supervision and performance review with line manager, proving feedback to promote collaborative working relationships
- Promote and maintain a positive, respectful and enthusiastic work environment

Personal accountability

- Compliance with Uniting's values, code of conduct, policies and procedures and relevant government legislation and standards where relevant.
- Cooperate with strategies to actively ensure the safety, protection and well-being of children who come into association with us.
- Ensure appropriate use of resources.
- Work collaboratively with Uniting (Victoria Tasmania) employees and external stakeholders in accordance with Uniting's values and professional standards of behaviour.
- Actively participate in initiatives to maintain, build upon and promote a positive and collaborative workplace.
- Identify opportunities to integrate and work collaboratively across teams.

- Promote a positive safety culture by contributing to health and safety consultation and communication.

5. Person specification

Qualifications

- A tertiary qualification in Clinical Psychology
- Registration as a psychologist with the Australian Health Practitioner Regulation Agency (AHPRA).

Experience

- Minimum of 2 years with Extensive experience working in mental health, ideally in crisis intervention, suicide prevention, or with high-risk populations.
- Experience providing clinical oversight, supervision, or leadership to other mental health professionals.
- Proven experience in working with clients experiencing suicidal ideation, attempted suicide, or those bereaved by suicide.
- Familiarity with community-based suicide prevention frameworks and interventions.
- Experience in care coordination, developing service pathways, and improving systems for atrisk populations.

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Core selection criteria

- Values alignment: Ability to demonstrate and authentically promote Uniting's values.
- **Child safety:** Demonstrated ability to provide safe environments for children and young people and protect them from abuse and neglect.
- **Communication:** excellent verbal and written communication skills to convey complex clinical information clearly to both clinicians and non-clinical stakeholders
- **Leadership:** Strong leadership qualities to guide, supervise, and support Step Thru Care clinicians, providing clear direction and constructive feedback while fostering a collaborative team environment. **Problem-Solving:** Strong critical thinking skills to identify gaps in suicide prevention systems, devise effective strategies, and adapt interventions quickly to meet the evolving needs of the community and high-risk individuals.
