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Overview

The Senior Business Analyst, part of the Business Strategy and Intelligence team, aims for to leverage Deakin's data assets to their fullest potential. The role requires proactive problem-solving with a technical understanding of data analytics and data warehousing, ability to elicit business needs and business processes and design high level solutions.

Reporting to the Director of Business Intelligence Systems and Services, the Senior Business Analyst will work collaboratively with stakeholders at all levels to elicit and manage requirements, conduct discovery and deliver analysis and design using appropriate business analysis methods, tools and techniques.

- Propose and design technical solutions to address business problems, including data models, transformations, workflows, system integrations, business processes and collaborate with developers and engineers to implement these solutions.
- Evaluate and baseline current state processes and performance to seek trends and analyse issues from diverse perspectives
- Utilise business analysis techniques to identify business needs and change opportunities, gather, document and analyse requirements and implement solutions, evaluate effectiveness and adjust actions as required.
- Consult a diverse range of stakeholders to define process and performance problems and negotiate inclusive and accessible solutions that contribute to the strategic goals of the University
- Engage in process improvement activities and adopt new ideas that increase value and efficiency of functions and services and actively encourage and coach others to question traditional assumptions, promote ideas and review practices and policies.
- Create and maintain detailed documentation for business requirements, processes, high level design and data flows.
- Lead improvements in the business analysis practice

- Propose and design technical solutions and monitor progress and risks in alignment with university strategies
- Collaborate with business users to gather and translate business needs into technical requirements and improve the broader team's ability to deliver key strategic initiatives.
- Promote teamwork and collaboration between the business and technical developers and offer coaching to enable team members to deliver high quality solutions.
- Use understanding of the customer context to anticipate needs, tailor services, improve service offering and ensure a high-quality outcome by addressing customer feedback and setting service standards.
- Actively encourage and coach others to question traditional assumptions, promotes ideas and review practices and policies and translate into workplace improvements.
- Analyse problems, weigh up a range of options to identify accessible and inclusive solutions and translate complex issues into clear and understandable goals and targets for Deakin.
- Proactively create, establish and retain professional networks, mutually beneficial relationships and considers practical application and alignment within Deakin.
- Address and resolve technical issues and challenges promptly
- Develop strategies to mitigate risks associated with data and system changes

Selection

- Postgraduate qualifications or progress towards postgraduate qualifications and extensive relevant experience; or

 - big data technologies such as Hadoop, Spark, or Kafka
 - creating and managing data models, understanding of data architecture
