Position Purpose

This position will support the Head of Industry Advancement in the delivery of Council's economic development priorities with a specific industry (lead) focus as outlined in the Regional Economic Development Strategy (REDS). This position will manage the delivery of specified strategic and complex projects that support delivery of REDS industry advancement and foster effective consultative and collaborative working relationships and networks with key stakeholders across the public and private sectors, on matters related to industry advancement/economic development of the region.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

Operational

As an industry lead and member of the Economic Development department you will:

- Lead industry development for the region, focusing on one or more of the REDS' pathways and/or priority industries and
 research and develop strategies and position papers (internally/externally) to guide economic development activities and
 programs.
- Lead or participate in a wide range of industry/business development and trade-related events and activities to showcase the Moreton Bay region's economy and/or further the priority industries outlined in the REDS.
- Develop and implement major project plans in line with Council's economic development agenda for initiatives for key industries, managing established budgets and contracts for assigned projects.
- Work collaboratively with the Principal Investment Leads and across Council departments to identify potential business investors from both outside and within the region and work to encourage their investment within the region.
- Consult and negotiate with a range of external stakeholders and partners.
- Represent the Economic Development Department and Council in a range of internal and external forums and meetings showcasing the Moreton Bay Region as an ideal business location.
- Undertake the collection and analysis of internal and external business-related data to facilitate business development strategies and specific investigations relating to economic development initiatives.
- Maintain a contemporary understanding of the economic climate, market conditions and regulatory environment for business and industry to provide informed advice to Council officers and clients to support business development and investment decisions.
