Purpose of Role

Provide efficient and effective management in the delivery of civil infrastructure projects undertaken by day labour (internal) construction crews, and other asset maintenance stakeholders

Specific Responsibilities

Lead a team in the delivery of a range of civil infrastructure construction projects providing leadership
with respect to cost and quality control of projects, workplace health and safety compliance,
environmental management, provision of construction input, planning and programming of works and
staff supervision.

Provide technical input into the resolution of construction problems while liaising with project owners
and other stakeholders.

- Maintain and review systems and procedures, performance measures and evaluation of work practices to improve the performance of the construction crews under this positions control.
- Ensure the application of modern civil engineering principles and practices.
- Project management and contract management of projects ensuring project variations are identified, raised, and submitted for approval in a timely manner.
- Undertake regular site inspections to monitor project progress and ensure the compliance of works in accordance with Council's inspection test plan, specifications and standards and identify, raise and approve (within authority limitations) non-conformances as per quality system.
- Provide leadership with respect to driving a customer focused culture within the Construction unit.
