

COVID-19: SA Health Recruitment Drive Criminal and Relevant History Screening

Criminal and Relevant History Screening

All prospective employees of SA Health are required to present a satisfactory criminal and relevant history screening assessment prior to commencement of employment. This requirement applies to all ongoing/permanent, temporary and casual roles.

How to apply for a National Police Certificate (NPC)

NPC application forms are accessible via the <u>SA Police website</u> or through an organisation accredited by the <u>Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission (ACIC)</u>.

ACIC has accredited the following list of providers authorised to offer a service directly to the general public, and may support you to submit an application for a police check online:

How to apply for a Working with Children Check

From 1 July 2019, everyone working or volunteering with children must have a Working with Children Check.

Current, valid child-related employment screening checks completed by the Department of Human Services (formerly the Department of Communities and Social Inclusion) will be recognised as a Working with Children Check until they expire.
