Role purpose

Responsible for the general maintenance of orderly conditions of grounds, buildings & vehicles.

Role responsibilities

This role suits someone with skills and experience in house and garden maintenance, with good attention to detail.

Deal with small, general items of repair and maintenance in the interior of the establishment (eg tidying storeroom, washing windows, watering plants)

Responsible for the monthly vehicle safety checks including checking tyre pressure, oil, water.

Report any faults or large maintenance requirements requiring specialist attention to the manager.

Working in the gardens including weeding, planting seeds & plants.

A 'C' class driver's license is a requirement of this role.

Knowledge, skills and experience

A 'C' class driver's license is desirable of this role.

Heavy lifting may be involved.

Physically capable of safely moving equipment.

Check requirements

- A National Criminal History Check prior to commencement and renewed every three years (Red Cross will arrange this)
- Working with Children's Check relevant to your state / territory location

Learning and development

- Complete Red Cross online learning modules as required
- Attend Red Cross Volunteer Induction, Program Training and ongoing training as required

General conditions
