Position Summary

A Research Associate/Post-Doctoral Fellow (Level A) is expected to contribute towards the research effort of the Centre for Future Health Systems at UNSW and to develop their research expertise through the pursuit of defined projects relevant to their particular field of research in collaboration with other researchers in the Centre.

The role of Research Associate/Post-Doctoral Fellow reports to the Director of the Centre for Future Health Systems and has no direct reports.

Accountabilities

Specific accountabilities for this role include:

- Contribute independently, and as a team member, in collaborative research leading to quality research outcomes in aspects of future health systems.
- Conduct research to create scholarly outputs, including research publications, that are recognised by peers.

- Undertake specific research activities and projects under the guidance of the Director of the Centre for Future Health Systems and contribute to development of research activities.
- Maintain a strong linkage to researchers in the Faculty of Arts, Design & Architecture.
- Contribute to the development of applications for competitive funding under the guidance of senior colleagues.
- Participate as a co-investigator or chief investigator in competitive grant applications, or show evidence
 of active participation in research collaborations funded by competitive grants.
- Support the dissemination of research outcomes through appropriate channels and outlets.
- Undertake discipline-appropriate research activities, e.g. rapid evidence synthesis, surveys, literature reviews, data gathering and/or recording of results using appropriate research methods.
- Participate in and/or present at conferences and/or workshops as required.
- Assist with the supervision of research students where required.
- Align with and actively demonstrate the <u>UNSW Values in Action: Our Behaviours</u> and the <u>UNSW Code</u>
 <u>of Conduct.</u>
- Cooperate with all health and safety policies and procedures of the university and take all reasonable care to ensure that your actions or omissions do not impact on the health and safety of yourself or others.
