Purpose

A 12-month trainee program to learn, develop and build skills across the range of content making roles in a regional bureau, creating multiplatform content that attracts and builds audiences in line with ABC Regional & Local's goals and strategies.

Key Accountabilities

- Under close direction of the Chief of Staff, develop the skills to create content for multiple platforms to engage and inform local, state, national and international audiences.
- Produce digital and social media content including taking, editing and uploading photos and videos.
- Pre-record straightforward interviews, voice reports and packages.
- Program production, recording and editing skills.
- Key aspects of reporting including writing basic feature stories.
- Proficiency in the use of electronic studio & field recording, replay & editing equipment.
- Develop skills in television reporting and production.
- Suggest content, research and compile stories that are interesting, accurate and of appropriate duration for radio programs

- Identify content to be shared with other ABC content teams for broader reach.
- Support local community activities, such as outside broadcasts
- Take part in and complete training modules as assigned throughout the program.
- Actively promote the ABC values and apply all relevant workplace policies and guidelines.
- Cooperate with any reasonable instruction, procedure or policy relating to safety and take reasonable care for your own safety and that of other people who may be affected by your conduct while at work.
