Position Purpose

This position will prepare moderately complex documentation and detailed engineering-based design for projects that incorporate a range of elements that form the built environment and are consistent with council's strategic outcomes of quality urban design and place making.

Responsibilities & Outcomes

As a civil designer within the design services team you will:

- Prepare moderately complex and integrated designs consistent with Council's strategic outcomes and policies of developing quality places around the needs of people drawing from contemporary best practice and standards.
- Apply technical design knowledge to the development of innovative solutions based outcomes that integrate transport, water sensitive design, streetscaping and urban design outcomes within the public realm and which interface with private spaces.
- Prepare accurate estimates of costs and project documentation using schedules of rates, bills of quantities and apply gained knowledge of identified issues that may impact on cost estimates.
- Act as a point of contact for design matters by providing sound advice, innovation and problem solving for management.
- Provide input into regular design review meetings and provide professional input at all stages of the design process including undertaking site inspections associated with design responsibilities.
- Processing of customer service inquiries and complaints referred for action.
- Contribute to a positive team environment in order to achieve a high performance, continuous improvement and customer focused culture.
- Build strong relationships with key stakeholders to obtain information to assist with completion of project designs and ensure service outcomes are achieved.
