

## The role of Referees

in the Dental Assistant selection process | Fact Sheet

All candidates are required to list the name and contact details of 3 relevant referees in their application.

It is imperative candidates approach any potential referees to **confirm their willingness** to be a referee before listing their details in applications and CV's.

## "Relevant" referees:

Are those able to provide pertinent information on a range of questions relating to the skills and attributes that match the **Dental Assistant role description** rather than a character reference.

> For current SA Dental employees –

A SA Dental Manager or Supervisor/Senior Dental Assistant who has worked with the candidate for a minimum of 3 months.

For external Dental Assistant applicants –
An Australian Dental professional who has worked with the candidate for a minimum of 3 months. You must have been working in a Dental Assisting capacity throughout this 3 month period.

## **Referee reports:**

- > The selection panel approaches referees via email to obtain information on the attributes of candidates against the requirements of the advertised role (as per the role description) to help determine each candidates suitability for employment.
- > For those who progress to interview the referee reports are scrutinised again as part of the selection process to determine each candidate's suitability for employment.
