POSITION OVERVIEW

Due to the significant growth in infrastructure development required at Deakin, the Infrastructure and Property Group's capital plan has increased to over \$750m in value over the next 5 years with significant growth in major interrelated building, civil, sustainability and services infrastructure projects at our Geelong Waurn Ponds Campus. The Senior Manager, Project Delivery will have responsibility for technical and people leadership of a team of professionals in the Major Projects Delivery, Regional group focussed on the delivery of an integrated programme of works including civil and services infrastructure, sustainability projects, specialist buildings for commercial partnerships within the Geelong Future Economy Precinct and other major projects.

Working closely with the General Manager, Major Projects Delivery, Regional and other Leadership Team members within the Infrastructure and Property Group the Senior Manager, Project Delivery will be responsible for high level technical and project management input into the translation of planned infrastructure and building project needs into deliverable project briefs including initial detailed investigation and scoping of planned projects, providing informed and accurate project delivery advice, detailed technical, financial and project methodology inputs to the business case and ultimately take responsibility for the delivery of a portfolio of approved projects. The Senior Manager, Project Delivery will also have leadership and staff management responsibilities for allocated Project Managers, Project Officers and Project administrative staff in line with project requirements.

- In partnership with the Organisational Sustainability Team, ensure all projects carefully consider Deakin's obligations and sustainability targets and contribute positively towards achieving these.
- Work with the Infrastructure and Property Group Leadership Team to assist to identify and forecast future civil and services infrastructure requirements and to continue the staged implementation of planned civil, infrastructure and serviced expansion projects ensuring future Project is not impeded.

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- Provide high level technical and project delivery inputs to comprehensive funding bids and business cases to present to the Deakin Portfolio Board (DPO) to achieve capital works projects fundamental to support the University's core business.
- Ensure the timely and effective implementation and delivery of civil, sustainability, services infrastructure and building projects in accordance with project parameters as approved in the business case.
- Lead, manage and mentor Project Managers and Project staff:
 - in the management of End Users and Stakeholders working closely with the Communications and Change Management Teams.
 - o in the successful implementation of planned project delivery methodologies and strategies providing detailed technical advice to assist in problem solving.
- Lead, manage and provide guidance to Project Managers and Project staff:
