Position Purpose

This position will operate Council trucks primarily for the transport of plant and machinery in a competent, safe and efficient way, and provide general labouring assistance as required.

Key Responsibilities and Outcomes

As a Low Loader Truck Operator and member of the Asset Maintenance Department you will:

- Operate low loader and tilt-tray trucks and other plant as required.
- Load, restrain, transport and unload various items of plant and machinery including but not limited to graders, rollers, excavators, drotts, front-end loaders, tractors, trucks, light vehicles, site sheds and shipping containers.
- Carry out daily checks, basic maintenance, servicing and cleaning of the vehicle/plant each day and report all defects in accordance with Council requirements.
- Correctly use and maintain plant and equipment provided, including all personal protective equipment, in accordance with manufacturer's instructions, Council's safety policy and procedures.
- Engage appropriately with a range of diverse internal and external stakeholders to ensure quality service delivery outcomes are achieved
