ABOUT THE ROLE

Role Purpose

This role is responsible for the development, delivery and evaluation of training, education and clinical practice competencies and capabilities for Home and Community Care (HACC) staff. The position works closely with the clinical and quality governance, practice excellence and local HACC teams to determine and plan learning needs for staff.

As the Clinical Educator, your role specifically will:

- Develop a training needs analysis framework and supporting tools in line with Uniting's clinical governance framework/policies as well as the current legislative standards and requirements.
- Conduct a training needs analysis in order to inform the development and implementation of service level training plans in consultation with each local leadership team.
- Monitor and drive service level training plans in close collaboration with each local leadership team.
- Develop and maintain clinical education training material based on Uniting's clinical governance framework/policies, Capability Framework (including the learning principles) as well as the current legislative standards and requirements.
- Deliver structured, flexible, and relevant training sessions to assist all learners in achieving their learning goals, facilitating the development of critical thinking and problem-solving.
- Assess and evaluate comprehensive education programs to meet ongoing competency in line with Uniting's clinical governance framework/policies, Capability Framework (including the learning principles) and current legislative standards and requirements.
- Work collaboratively with Clinical Governance, Practice Excellence and the Area Managers to support staff development with clinical educational activities.
- Collect and assess data and information related to education needs, including the identification of trends, issues and supporting data to determine a comprehensive, fit for purposes education program.
- Provide guidance, resources, and knowledge to support the professional growth of others.
- Mentor clinical staff, colleagues', students, and others as appropriate.
- Embed a culture of reflective practice through clinical supervision.
- Act as an educational consultant to management and support projects related to policy, procedure, and program development.
- Collaborate with Clinical Governance and Practice Excellence to recommend educational strategies for the implementation of clinical standards.

It is expected that you will possess good skills at navigating a complex organisation, forging relationships, and managing through influence rather than direct authority as required.
