Primary Purpose:

Provide personal laundry services to all areas of Roy Fagan Centre.

Duties:

- 1. Operation of washing and drying machines in laundry
- 2. Ironing of garments as required.
- 3. Collection and delivery of garments to and from units.
- 4. Cleaning laundry floor as required.
- 5. Maintaining up to date knowledge of equipment, policies, procedures, and safety requirements in the laundry service.
- 6. Organise and order laundry related chemicals and products.
- 7. Special infection control laundry cleaning as required.
- 8. Maintaining of linen trolley and ordering of linen room stock.



- 9. Ensure equipment is used and maintained in the correct manner and report faults to enable corrective action to be taken.
- 10. Actively participate in and contribute to the organisation's Quality & Safety and Work Health & Safety processes, including in the development and implementation of safety systems, improvement initiatives, safeguarding practices for vulnerable people, and related training.
- 11. The incumbent can expect to be allocated duties, not specifically mentioned in this document, that are within the capacity, qualifications and experience normally expected from persons occupying positions at this classification level.

Key Accountabilities and Responsibilities:

- Direction and supervision are provided by the relevant Operational Manager
- Responsible to the relevant Operational Manager for a high standard of laundry across relevant work areas.
- Ability and willingness to work in all areas of Statewide Mental Health Services in various capacities as required.
- Ensure a caring and courteous manner is shown towards patients, relatives, and members of the public.
- Champion a child safe culture that upholds the National Principles for Child Safe Organisations. The Department
 is committed to the safety, wellbeing, and empowerment of all children and young people, and expect all
 employees to actively participate in and contribute to our rights-based approach to care, including meeting
 all mandatory reporting obligations.
- Where applicable, exercise delegations in accordance with a range of Acts, Regulations, Awards, administrative authorities and functional arrangements as mandated by Statutory office holders including the Secretary and Head of State Service. The relevant Unit Manager can provide details to the occupant of delegations applicable to this position.
- Comply at all times with policy and protocol requirements, including those relating to mandatory education, training and assessment.

Pre-employment Conditions:

It is the Employee's responsibility to notify an Employer of any new criminal convictions during the course of their employment with the Department.

The Head of the State Service has determined that the person nominated for this job is to satisfy a pre-employment check before taking up the appointment, on promotion or transfer. The following checks are to be conducted:

- I. Conviction checks in the following areas:
 - a. crimes of violence
 - b. sex related offences
 - c. serious drug offences
 - d. crimes involving dishonesty
- 2. Identification check
- 3. Disciplinary action in previous employment check.





Selection Criteria:

- 1. Previous laundry and linen service experience.
- 2. Awareness of, and familiarity with, equipment currently in use within the commercial linen and laundry industry.
- 3. A basic knowledge of laundry related procedures and solutions.
- 4. Understanding of safe manual handling techniques.
- 5. Ability to work effectively individually or in a team environment and to communicate effectively with colleagues and clients.
- 6. Knowledge of the current principles of infection control.
