You will also provide support for specialised, bespoke teaching and research solutions and design/implement new systems in accordance with appropriate build guidelines and processes. You will work proactively to identify problem candidates, perform root cause analysis (RCA), develop checklists and documentation for known problems and make recommendations for problem prevention.

Your key responsibilities

Provide desktop IT Support to users of Apple and Windows PCs and supported mobile devices.

Administer and monitor Linux and Apple servers ensuring maximum availability and performance.

With the Perkins Building IT Manager, administer and monitor the network hardware, access and distribution layer within the Institute

Document all aspects of the systems and services, backup and disaster recovery procedures

Develop and manage the IT budget; manage the IT procurement cycle from purchase to disposal and manage the asset database.

Manage procurement of software and a software asset database.

Maintain knowledge of industry trends
