How do I apply to the Employment Register?

What will I need when applying for the Employment Register?

Complete the quick and easy online application form.

You won't need any documents. You will be asked some information about yourself including contact information, qualifications, work rights, employment areas of interest, such as Administration, Allied Health, Catering/Cleaning, Direct Care/Aged Care, Medical or Nursing/Midwifery. The type of employment you are seeking such as ongoing, temporary or casual. Your preferred work location such as Mount Gambier, Naracoorte, Penola, Keith, Bordertown, Kingston/Robe, Millicent or Lucindale.

How will I receive further communication?

Communication will be via email or phone if you prefer. When you apply, you will be asked for an email address that will be used to correspond with you regarding your registration.

If your email or contact details change, please update them by visiting <u>www.health.sa.gov.au/careers</u>: Log in using your profile, select 'Edit Profile', click on 'Personal Details', update your details and then save. This is a live system, so you can update personal details at any time.

What happens if I find a vacancy I am interested in?

Complete the online application form for that specific vacancy and attach your supporting documents:

A covering letter up to 2 pages describing your skills, abilities, knowledge, qualifications and experience in relation to the position

- Current resume or curriculum vitae
- · Contact details of at least two referees including email and telephone details
- A copy of the Criminal History checks requested (if you have them)
- COVID Immunisation information

How long will LCLHN hold my registration?

Expressions of Interest (EOI) will be accepted on a continuing basis for a period of 12 months. You may withdraw your EOI at any time should you no longer wish to be considered for a position.
