Work collaboratively within the teaching teams and support the University's commitment to equity and diversity principles

Undertake administrative duties and service roles as required by the Head of Discipline

### Your specific work capabilities (selection criteria)

Unrestricted registration as a Podiatrist by the Podiatry Board of Australia

Demonstrated knowledge of, and teaching experience in, Podiatric Medicine and/or Podiatric Surgery, including scheduled medicines, in a University environment. A teaching portfolio is recommended evidence of teaching experience

Demonstrated ability to administer and coordinate academic units and programs in teaching and learning

Ability to demonstrate innovative and flexible teaching methods, such as case enhanced learning and e-learning

Evidence of supervision of students' research in a university environment

Demonstrated excellence in management and organisational skills and leadership qualities

Evidence of a high level of interpersonal skills, verbal and written communication, and demonstrated ability to relate well to staff and students at all levels
