Position Context/Purpose

The Network Infrastructure Manager at La Trobe University plays a critical role in maintaining and enhancing the university's Cisco software-defined network, including both wireless and wired infrastructures. Reporting to the Associate Director, Network Management, this position is responsible for ensuring that the network is secure, fit for purpose, and operates efficiently. The role focuses on the management and continuous improvement of the network infrastructure, driving automation and alignment with best practices to support the university's strategic objectives. Leading a team of Network Engineers, the Network Infrastructure Manager ensures the delivery of high-quality network services that meet the university's needs.

Key Duties & Accountabilities

- Develop and implement network infrastructure programs aligned with university policies and external requirements.
- Provide strategic support and advice to various university departments, ensuring policies are integrated and objectives achieved within complex organisational structures.
- Propose and implement changes to work processes, policies, and procedures to enhance service quality and effectiveness.
- Apply substantial theoretical and professional knowledge to manage network programs, develop policies, and evaluate initiatives.
- Provide expert advice, guidance, and specialist resources to address significant problems or multi-disciplinary issues.
- Offer professional or consultancy advice beyond the university.
- Manage administrative, technical, and professional staff, allocating responsibilities, reviewing performance, and overseeing network program procedures and priorities.
- Oversee network infrastructure projects, ensuring they are delivered to specification, on time, and within budget.
- Manage allocated budgets/resources and control expenditure to achieve targets within budget constraints.
- Provide advice to higher-level staff on network program objectives, organisational structures, and budget expenditure.
- Negotiate solutions among various interests, accommodating contributors with different areas of expertise.
- Evaluate service provision and external market feedback to propose innovative solutions that enhance service quality, efficiency, and continuity.
- Develop and enable staff capabilities through continuous performance monitoring, mentoring, and constructive feedback.
- Encourage professionals to achieve university objectives, providing strategic support and advice to schools, divisions, and departments.

Essential Criteria

Skills and knowledge required for the position

- **Network Architecture**: Solid understanding of enterprise network architecture principles, including designing, configuring, and optimising network topologies.
- Routing and Switching: Proficiency in routing protocols (e.g., OSPF, BGP) and switching technologies (e.g., Cisco Catalyst 9000 series).
- **Wireless Networking**: Experience in designing, deploying, and managing wireless networks, including access point placement and RF optimisation.
- Network Monitoring and Management: Familiarity with network monitoring tools (e.g., Cisco DNAC) to proactively monitor performance and troubleshoot issues.

- **TCP/IP Networking**: Understanding of TCP/IP protocols, subnetting, IP addressing, and DNS/DHCP configuration.
- Load Balancing: Knowledge of load balancing principles and technologies (e.g., F5 BIG-IP).
- **Network Virtualisation**: Familiarity with virtualisation technologies (e.g., VMware NSX, Cisco ACI).
- Accreditations/Licences: Hold a current valid industry recognisable accreditation (CCNA, CCNP, CCIE) and basic knowledge of any programming language (preferable Python) and Rest API's)
- **Vendor Management**: Ability to evaluate network hardware and software vendors, negotiate contracts, and manage vendor relationships to procure network equipment and services that meet organisational needs.
- **Documentation and Compliance**: Proficiency in documenting network configurations, policies, and procedures, ensuring compliance with regulatory requirements and industry standards.
- **Disaster Recovery and Business Continuity**: Knowledge of disaster recovery planning and business continuity strategies.
- A degree, extensive management expertise and supporting experience, or postgraduate qualifications and extensive relevant experience, or an equivalent alternate combination of relevant knowledge, training and/or experience.

Capabilities required to be successful in the position

- Strategic thinking and planning to align network infrastructure with university goals.
- Expertise in applying technical knowledge to solve complex problems and provide innovative solutions.
- Strong leadership and management skills to guide a team of Network Engineers and ensure high performance.
- Effective communication and interpersonal skills to engage with stakeholders and negotiate solutions.
- Financial acumen to manage budgets and ensure cost-effective use of resources.
- Commitment to continuous improvement and staying abreast of industry trends and best practices in network management.
