POSITION PURPOSE

The Business Development Manager supports the Senior Business Development Manager in the delivery of the Faculty of Science's industry and government partner engagement and research business development. This includes managing a range of strategic and operational activities including the identification and cultivation of industry and government research opportunities aligned to Faculty strategic research priorities; the provision of timely advice and support to the Faculty's academic researchers for costing and pricing of the Faculty's research contracts, consultancies, tenders and industry-related grants; the development and implementation of contractual agreements in line with Faculty and University processes; and the coordination of other engagement initiatives as they arise across the Faculty of Science and the broader University. The position provides leadership to the Associate Dean of Research, Heads of School and Research Directors in the delivery of high-level and professional services for the achievement of the Faculty of Science's priorities and provides expert advice at both strategic and operational levels.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Contribute to strategic planning and the achievement of goals relevant to the Faculty's BD team, specifically the development and management of a pipeline of new research business opportunities consistent with the aspirations and strategic priorities of the Faculty and the University leading to increased research collaborations, a diversification of research funding and the delivery of successful outcomes
- 2. Co-ordinate and oversee the Faculty's operations relating to research business development in accordance with University policies, procedures and strategic priorities by actively driving the development and presentation of pitches and research proposals to prospective funding partners, together with researchers, from inception through to submission
- **3.** Provide a range of research business development services in accordance with University policies and procedures relating to the preparation of grants, tenders, contract research and other research opportunities including costing and pricing
- **4.** Plan and drive the review and negotiation of research contracts with industry, government and other funding partners with advice from the University's Office of General Counsel, Contracts Management Office and other functional specialists
- 5. Manage and co-ordinate a work environment of continuous review and improvement of business development practices, operational processes and service provision including the prompt resolution of issues with adherence to privacy, confidentiality and legislative compliance requirements
- **6.** Provide expert, specialist advice and guidance to Faculty leadership and senior researchers pertaining to research business, intellectual property, risk, compliance and other commercial considerations to support delivery of strategic priorities for the Faculty and the University
- 7. Drive the maintenance of accurate records and files to track proposals, project developments and potential agreement revenue using the University's systems and other data repositories and oversee the regular reporting of the Faculty research business pipeline

- **8.** Develop and maintain strong partnerships with other relevant business units, functional areas and key staff, including provision of expert advice
- 9. Other duties as directed from time to time

KEY SELECTION CRITERIA

Education/Qualifications

- 1. The appointee will have:
 - A degree in a relevant scientific field with postgraduate qualifications in business administration and/or subsequent relevant commercial experience; or
 - A combination of equivalent relevant experience and/or education/training.

Knowledge and Skills

- **2.** Experience in business development including planning, commercial and contractual negotiations, and management in a research-intensive environment
- **3.** Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, including the ability to build rapport, negotiate and build consensus at senior levels with a broad range of internal and external stakeholders and work well within cross functional teams exercising high levels of independence, judgement and initiative
- 4. Demonstrated experience in working with researchers to develop technical proposals of commercial interest with a strong awareness of risk assessment, intellectual property, confidentiality and scholarly considerations
- **5.** Highly developed planning and organisational skills, with experience establishing priorities, allocating resources and meeting deadlines
- **6.** Strong written communication skills, including attention to detail
- **7.** Demonstrated ability to provide authoritative advice on appropriate policy and legislation, together with the capacity to apply this knowledge to individual situations
- **8.** Highly developed analytical and conceptual skills including demonstrated ability to deliver positive solutions to complex problems
- **9.** An understanding of and empathy with the higher education sector and with research undertaken in the Faculty of Science
